G/T Talk...

Gifted and Talented classes at FHSA are learning more and more each day. We have had a great nine weeks. Our theme for our class is, "WE ARE SUPER HEROS". Third grade students created a model of their own super hero that mimicked their own personality. Students had to write a comic that featured their super hero and emphasize the trait that related to them personally.

The month of October was dedicated to learning the scientific method. Students performed experiments that included recording multiple trials, observing, and recording and reporting results. Students were taught how to make a hypothesis and word it correctly. After each experiment, students stated their conclusions. Background research allowed students to connect the science facts that supported each result. GT students are also learning about team building. Students are being placed in groups of two and three to accomplish a design challenge. We have created innovations out of paper, index cards, tape, and tissue boxes. Once we finish a challenge, we rate our productivity, work effort, and communication skills.

All lessons are designed using the LRSD Gifted and Talented scope and sequence of skills, current events, embedded research. and common core standards. Each unit taught in G/T is based on a STEM concept to enhance our students thinking.
